HAVE YOUR SAY: Proposed Dog Off-Leash Area at Jutland Road Park

Dog ownership and the use of public open spaces are important aspects of community life and wellbeing in Ward 77. Many residents have expressed interest in identifying designated areas where dogs can safely exercise off-leash, while ensuring that the needs of all park users are respected.

In terms of Section 7.3 of Part 25 of the Council's System of Delegations, Sub-Councils are authorised to designate, in accordance with Section 10 of the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By-law (2021), specific public areas as free-running, on-leash, or off-limits for dogs. These designations may also vary according to time of day or season, where appropriate.

And so, we would like to invite residents and stakeholders to share their views on the proposal that a portion of Jutland Road Park be designated as an off-leash area.
